So make sure you book your trip, and I look forward to meeting you in Naples!



HbbTV 2.0.4 and Application Discovery over Broadband

HbbTV has just placed orders for the unit tests for HbbTV 2.0.4 and for the audio watermark part of the watermark-based targeted advertising found in the most recent version of our 'Application Discovery over Broadband' specification. Delivery of these tests should be completed by the end of 2023.

In an effort to accelerate the maturity of the tests and break the usual chickenand-egg deadlock, HbbTV has also ordered minimal implementations of the 2.0.4 features to be used for test acceptance. After careful evaluation of the RfP responses by our Supplier Evaluation Working Group, the orders were mostly awarded to Ocean Blue Software with test streams and service lists for DVB-I to be provided by Sofia Digital.
